Sharon Pruess, City Planner, presented Resolution 2622 to adopt the NE Pierre Transportation and Access Management Plan. The City has worked with SD Department of Transportation on the development of the plan. HDR was hired to conduct the study and develop the plan. They held several public meetings and offered many opportunities for the public to comment. The study area included north Euclid, 1804, Highway 14 to Truck Route, Kingsway, and North Airport Road. On February 6th the Planning Commission recommended adoption of the plan. HDR representative Joe Blow provided an overview of the final report. Commissioner Mehlhaff moved and Commissioner Huizenga seconded to approve Resolution 2622. Unanimous approval.

RESOLUTION NO. 2622

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE NORTHEAST PIERRE TRANSPORTATION AND ACCESS MANAGEMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, the City is committed to implementing a plan to guide development of the City's future transportation system to serve the community's needs and an access management policy that reduces highway congestion,

minimizes traffic delay, improves traffic flow, preserves highway capacity, and reduces accidents along the U.S. Highways, State Highways and City streets, identified in the plan, and

WHEREAS, the City is further committed to preventing any conditions from occurring in the development, design, and operation of the local transportation plan that cause or contribute to a decline in the highway's designated and intended traffic function and that require excessive expenditure of public funds to correct, and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Plan has been prepared under the supervision and funding of the South Dakota Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration, with cooperation and participation of the City of Pierre, Hughes County and the citizens of the area; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission reviewed the plan, accepted public comments, and recommended approval of the Access Plan at a meeting on February 26, 2018,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Pierre Board of Commissioners does hereby adopt the NE Pierre Transportation and Access Management Plan, including all pertinent maps, figures, tables and descriptive matter included in the appendix of the plan, copies of which will be maintained and available for viewing by the general public at City Hall.

This being the time and place to consider the Retail on/off sale malt beverage and on/off sale wine licenses for The Expedition League at Hyde Stadium, Mayor Harding opened the hearing. Tom Farnsworth, Park & Recreation Director, explained that the City has a lease agreement with the Expedition League for a wood-bat collegiate baseball league to play at Hyde Stadium. Part of that agreement provides full access to concessions and they would like to offer beer and wine sales at their Trapper games. The alcohol would not be available and any youth games and all sales would be segregated from other food and beverage concession sales to allow for youth to work concessions. Police Chief Jason Jones commented that he has worked with Steve Wagner on the plans and has no issues with the proposed layout and sales plan. Twila Hight, Finance Officer, explained that a Memorandum of Understanding has been drafted that explains that beer and wine sales will only be offered as "on-sale" to be purchased and consumed on premise, no "off-sale" service will be provided, and sales will only be provided at Trapper games not at any other youth games, and for any special events the Expedition League would need Commission permission. Being no one else present to comment, Mayor Harding closed the hearing. Commissioner Huizenga moved and Commissioner Johnson approved the Retail on/off sale malt beverage and on/off sale wine license for the Expedition League at Hyde Stadium. Unanimous approval. Commissioner Huizenga moved and Commissioner Johnson seconded to approve the MOU between the City of Pierre and Expedition League at Hyde Stadium as presented. Unanimous approval.

John Childs, City Engineer, presented the bid received for the 2018 Curb & Gutter project and recommended award. The only bid was received from Sharpe Enterprises for \$396,028 and since it exceeded the engineers estimate but within 10%, the City was able to negotiate down to \$391,056. Bid Alternate #1 for removal of curb & gutter by the Health Lab at Governor's Drive and 4th Street intersection was recommended to not be awarded for \$12,709.50 and the City will perform this work. Commissioner Barringer moved and Commissioner Mehlhaff seconded to award the 2018 Curb & Gutter bid to Sharpe Enterprises for \$391,056. Unanimous approval.

John Childs, City Engineer, presented the bid received for 2018 Street Paving and recommended award to Morris Inc. The bid included Schedule A for \$1,840,666.25 and Schedule A Alternate 1 for mico-milling for \$193,107, Schedule B for flush sealing & sand for \$39,187.50, and Schedule C for patch mix schedule of values. The micro-milling was added this year to review a possible cost savings to have the removal of the asphalt micro-milled to avoid additional milling of the normal size pieces as in past years. Based on cost, this option will not be accepted. Commissioner Barringer moved and Commissioner Huizenga seconded to award the bid for 2018 Street Paving to Morris Inc for \$1,840,666.25 and schedule B for \$39,187.50, and Schedule C for schedule of values. Unanimous approval.

John Childs, City Engineer, presented the bids received for the Steamboat Trail Rehab project and recommended award to low bid Quality Construction for \$89,997.35. Other bids were received by FRS DBA Solbros Construction for \$92,738.37, R&W Construction for \$97,323.75, Midwest Construction for \$99,079.47, Sharpe Enterprises for \$101,887.80, Custom Concrete for \$108,011.75, Precision Concrete for \$136,867.59, and G&N Construction for \$171,295.80. Commissioner Johnson moved and Commissioner Barringer seconded to award the bid for the Steamboat Trail Rehab project and recommended award to low bid Quality Construction for \$89,997.35. Unanimous approval.

Tom Farnsworth, Park & Recreation Director, presented a renewal of the SD Discover Center Lease Agreement for 2018 thru 2020. The lease terms are mostly the same with some updates for utility clarifications and the addition of a vehicle. The City has a 2008 Chevy Impala that was scheduled to be surplused after the replacement arrived. The vehicle will be included with the lease agreement. Kristie Maher, Executive Director, commented that she appreciates all the City's support and assistance in the building and looks forward to another 3 year term. Commissioner Johnson moved and Commissioner Barringer seconded to approve the SD Discovery Center Lease Agreement as presented. Unanimous approval.

John Childs, City Engineer, presented change order #1/final on the Airport Fire Station (ARFF) building project. There are several quantity adjustments but the majority of the change comes from additional geogrid required due to underground water encountered during construction for \$9,000 and liquidated damages for exceeding the completion date for \$17,500. Commissioner Barringer moved and Commissioner Mehlhaff seconded to approve change order #1/final on the Airport Fire Station (ARFF) building project for an additional \$2,255.63. Unanimous approval.
