Staff Reports

Chad Wise, clubhouse manager

Chad reported that he is learning the POS system and the names of all the members. During the recent High school girl's tournament, he reported that Carin Hayn assisted with Golf Genius tournament software and he is taking time to learn how it works. The course has been very busy with the warm weather and good spring course conditions. Chad reported that most of his merchandise is in stock. Clothing is in but waiting on a few items (i.e. clubs and ball order)

Jordan Steiner, Superintendent

The irrigation system was charged up on April 20th and only 3 overnight cycles have run due to freezing night time temperature. When charging up no leaks were found which allowed for other work to be completed. Jordan reported the crew has almost completed a new path to 13 white tee box. Sod was harvested from 13 white tee area to repair damage near the parking lot during winter snow removal. Monday, May 8th aeration is scheduled for the greens. Bayonet tines, topdressing, and rolling will be the process. This process has a fast recovery and minimal disturbance to the putting surface. State Girls High school golf is scheduled for June 5-6. Jordan also reported the 80 year old (1942) air compressor used to blow off equipment has died and a replacement has been purchased.

Bryan Tipton CGCS, Director

During the changeover of the point of sale system and tee sheet software from Fore Reservations/Golf Now to Square/Birrdi it was found an old online tee program was still active. Tipton worked with Golf Now to get Hillsview removed and shut down the old program. Tipton also reported it will take a little time to develop the customer base in Square but once the data is collected it will be much easier to check in and track sales and memberships. The new system uses your individual phone number as the account indicator.
