**Staff Reports**

**Carin Hayn, PGA professional, clubhouse manager**

There was one event in April, which was the high school girl's invite. Pierre finished 4<sup>th</sup> place. The low score of the day which was a girl from Aberdeen and RC Stevens who shot 77. Tomorrow, the HLGGA will start their Tuesday's league play. This coming Saturday is our opening OMGA tournament. We currently have 10 teams, 20 players. We are scheduled to have a 9 AM start with a meeting and lunch afterward. May 16<sup>th</sup> is the high school 5B region for boys' and girls' tournament. They have the pre-region on Monday and then the next Monday, the 23<sup>rd</sup> is their qualifying. There will be around 80 players or so. On Tuesday, May 24<sup>th</sup> we are hosting ESD girls this year. We are trying to do a double tee start on 1 and 10. We had one change in the calendar which was the Junior Achievement which will move to the Fall, which will be September 8<sup>th</sup>. Season passes so far is 77, which is only 25 off from this time last year. We have had 1631 rounds in April. The weather has been kicking us hard so far. We have only hit 70 degrees in April so I thought that was interesting as well. Last meeting, we spoke about the request from the high school activities association for hosting the girls tournament. Yankton is supposed to host next year and we got a request to switch them for next year. We will host the AA girl's event in 2023 instead of 2024.

**Jordan Steiner, Superintendent**

We got our irrigation system all complete. We are basically doing computer based stuff for it now. We are able to run this a lot more from the computer instead of having to do each head individually. Soil temps right now are 50 degrees in the greens and 47 degrees in the fairways.

Tipton-Optimum growth is 55 degrees.

Seasonals are going to start tomorrow. They are starting about 3 weeks later than normal because we haven't had a lot to mow. We installed the weather station today as well. We are going to start to do a lot of different things with it.

Conzemius- Are we able to look at that stuff on our phones?

Steiner- We are still working on those details.

Steiner- As you can see we have some dead spots but in speaking with other courses they are all struggling as well. Some courses are lost greens.

Conzemius- What about our greens?

Tipton- We don't know yet because it hasn't been nice enough yet.

Steiner- We did purchase some extra seed for this year so just in case we have to cover those greens up.

Steiner- We usually start to aerate in May, but we are thinking that we will wait until June to give them some more time.

Tipton- June.

Keeton- If we wanted to hire an architect to come in, could we put in a request for that?

Johnson- Yes, that is something that I would support.

Bartlett- I think that would be good because then we would know exactly what they suggest and we have something to point as for future requests.
