The City of Pierre Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on May 9, 2023 with Commissioners Barringer, Huizenga, Todd Johnson, and Vona Johnson present for roll call. Mayor Harding was absent and Commissioner Huizenga presided over the meeting. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. No one from the ministry was present for the invocation. The agenda was approved as posted. No one was present for public comment.

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Bryan Tipton, Parks and Recreation Director, gave an update on the Outdoor Pool Project construction.

Brad Palmer, Utilities Director, presented the Bid Award for the Washbay Project. Palmer stated four bids were received and three bids were read. Palmer recommended award to low bidder Sharpe Enterprises for \$2,200,000. Other bids received and read were Midwest Construction for \$2,498.961.56 and A-G-E Corporation for \$2,850,000. Commission Barringer moved and Commissioner Todd Johnson seconded to approve the Bid Award for the Washbay Project to Sharpe Enterprises for \$2,200,000 as presented. Unanimous approval.

This being the time and place to consider the Oahe Days Temporary Alcohol License for June 15-18, 2023 at Steamboat Park, Commissioner Huizenga opened the hearing. Julie Diedrich, Oahe Days Organizer, was present and explained the temporary license is the same as in years past in Steamboat Park. Police Chief Jason Jones commented that there will be an officer presence in the park and an officer is on the planning committee to help advice to the safe sale of alcohol. Being no one else present to comment, Commissioner Huizenga closed the hearing. Commissioner Vona Johnson moved and Commissioner Todd Johnson seconded to approve the Oahe Days Temporary Alcohol License for June 15-18 as presented. Unanimous approval.

Bryan Tipton, Parks and Recreation Director, provided a list of request items for the Oahe Days Event. These items include beer garden; amphitheater stage and power; street closure request and barriers on Missouri, Central, and Island View Drive; picnic tables and benches; one call locates and mosquito control; Homan Foos ball inflatable; Electric and Water department support for vendors; and live music after 10pm. Total fees are \$450. Commissioner Todd Johnson moved and Commissioner Vona Johnson seconded to approve the list of request items for Oahe Days as presented. Unanimous approval.

Emeline Hoblick, City Planner, presented an introduction of Plat of Lot 21 Replat of Camelot Addition, Gary & Patricia Heintz. Heintz owns an approximate five acre lot and wishes to subdivide it into two separate lots. City Planning Commission recommended approval of the plat at the May 8, 2023 meeting. Emeline Hoblick, City Planner, presented an introduction of Plat of Tract 1 of Center Point Addition, for Chapelle Investments LLC. Chapelle Investments LLC proposes to consolidate the multiple parcels into one parcel for the development of the area for the new hotel, apartment building, and retail space. The City Planning Commission recommended approval of the plat at the May 8, 2023 meeting.

Brian Cowles, Airport Manager, presented a request to bid an Airport ARFF Truck. Cowles explained the new truck will be replacing a 14 year old piece of equipment that they airport will keep as a backup. Commissioner Huizenga moved and Commissioner Vona Johnson seconded to approve the request to bid the Airport ARFF Truck. Unanimous approval.

Brian Cowles, Airport Manager, presented an airport terminal lease agreement with Capital Auto Rental, DBA AVIS. Cowles explained the previous lease has expired and this new ten year lease has provisions for both the terminal and parking spaces. The lessee has agreed to the new terms of \$18.91 per square foot, totaling \$3,479.44 per year to be adjusted by CPI-U annually and 10% of gross sales due monthly. Commissioner Huizenga moved and Commissioner Vona Johnson seconded to approve the airport terminal lease agreement with Capital Auto Rental (AVIS) as presented. Unanimous approval.

Lacey Walz, Deputy Finance Officer, presented the first reading of the budget supplement for the Washbay Project. Commissioner Barringer gave first reading to Ordinance 1854 AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTAL TO ORDINANCE NO. 1845, THE 2023

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR NECESSARY FUNCTIONS OF GOVERNMENT FOR WHICH NO APPROPRIATIONS OR INSUFICIENT APPROPRIATIONS WERE PROVIDED. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PIERRE, SD.
