On that Saturday, we had the Booster club tournament. The 28th was a fairly active day as well with the GFP tournament, some mid-day play, and then the Pink Ball Classic. The men's divot league also played that evening. The next day, that Friday we had 261 recorded rounds which was a record for us. Some of those were practice rounds for the two-woman. We had our two-woman championship that weekend. The OMGA and the HLGA chipped in to provide lunch for all of the players on Sunday. Today the SDGA held the Junior Tour Championship. The kids have to qualify to play in that event and those started at 10 AM. For the upcoming, we are only 11 days out from the Dessert Classic. Following that we have the Housebuilders on August 19th. The boy's high school team will start practice here very soon. Their invite will be Tuesday, August 23rd. The HLGA and the OMGA championships are scheduled for this month as well. Last year was a boom year for revenues and we are still doing better than that this year. We are two ahead of last year for season pass sales at 458.

Since we last spoke, we talked about pulling cores this fall but we are going to wait until next spring to pull cores when we complete the spring aerification. We have a lot of events and it was hard to find a 10-day period. This fall we will bayonet tine a little more aggressively, with holes every inch instead of every 3 inches. The tighter spacing makes more holes which we need to help repair damaged areas that have not been filled in from winter damage. We are going to have to reseed the left side of 11 because of flooding earlier this year. We will be hand watering a lot of the greens this week as well because of the hot weather. We are going to finish up edging the bunkers so those are ready to go for the Dessert Classic.
