

## Rawlins Municipal Library Board

September 27, 2021

### MINUTES

The Rawlins Municipal Library Board held its monthly meeting on Monday, September 27<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m. in the South Dakota Room. Amy Weller, Jill Kruger, Sue Douglas, Sarah Aker, Commissioner Representative Vona Johnson, and Library Director Robin Schrupp were in attendance. Renae Lehman was absent.

President Weller called the meeting to order. The consent calendar which included the agenda and the August minutes were reviewed. A motion for approval was made by Aker, seconded by Kruger. There were no public comments to address.

General circulation for the month of August was 7,114. A total of 2,033 eBooks were checked out and 693 internet/computer uses were recorded. Physical patron count was 3,100; open 31 days, an average of 100/day.
